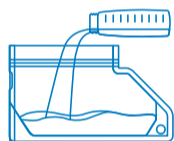

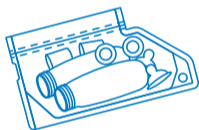
## microwave steriliser bags

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

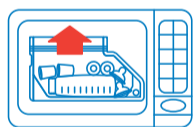
1. Ensure bottles, teats, collars and caps are clean before sterilisation. Pour **70ml** of water into the bag. Bottles could be damaged if insufficient water is poured into the bag.



2. Pack items for sterilisation into the bag, direction for bottles as per diagram.



3. Do not over fill the bag, and ensure the zip is fastened completely. Microwave on maximum heat for **3 minutes**.



4. Remove bag from the microwave **holding the top section** of the bag only. The bag will be extremely hot after the cycle, so it is important that you use a cloth, towel or oven gloves to remove.



5. Leave the bag to cool for 10 minutes. Do not open the bag until you have drained the hot water out of the bags exhaust.



6. Remove sterilised contents from the bag, rinse out and dry for reuse.

### WARNINGS

- These bags are only suitable for use in regular **500W - 1000W** domestic microwave ovens.
- Do not sterilise bottles with teats and accessories fitted.
- Place bottles in the bag only according to the direction indicated.
- Bags are not suitable for cooking purposes.
- Bags should not be used in appliances other than a microwave oven.
- The bag should not be placed on top of a metal grid or dish as this will result in the bag melting.
- The requirement of 70ml of water and a heating time of 3 minutes must be adhered to otherwise the contents in the bag will be damaged.
- The bag must be placed in the microwave the correct way up and the bag **must rotate**.
- If the bag shows any sign of damage, it must be discarded immediately.
